GOALS & OBJECTIVES/PRE-K

The following is a list of goals and objectives that we hope your child will achieve While in Pre-K. Please keep in mind that not all children progress at the same level. Therefore, these goals and objectives are meant to serve only as a guideline.

- 1) Recognize and print names and memorize phone numbers.
- 2) Identify letters of the alphabet (both upper and lowercase).
- 3) Print upper and lowercase letters
- 4) Know phonetic sounds of the letters of the alphabet and memorize basic sight words.
- 5) Cut straight and wavy lines and simple shapes.
- 6) Will master fine motor skills age-appropriate (in printing, cutting, coloring with in the lines, dot to dot and etc).
- 7) Master gross motor skills age-appropriate (hop, skip, jump, swing, catch and throw a ball).
- 8) Identify body parts.
- 9) Visual discrimination and sequencing events.
- 10) Use left and right progression.
- 11) Use of appropriate terms for common terms.
- 12) Auditory discrimination using rhyming words.
- 13) Categorize objects.
- 14) Demonstration of proper use of ordinary numbers.
- 15) Recognize and print 1-20 and understand number concepts 1-20.
- 16) Can identify basic geometric shapes such as triangle, square, rectangle, circle and identify colors.
- 17) Can give properties of basic geometric shapes and equal parts.
- 18) Able to recognize sets that are equal, greater or less than.
- 19) Able to make patterns, classify items and graph.
- 20) Exploring addition and subtraction.
- 21) Measurement-estimation and weights.
- 22) Time: Digital and analog clocks.
- 23) Money (recognize differences).

CREATIVE CHILDREN PRE-SCHOOL

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Our educational program promotes intellectual development in the areas of language development, reading readiness, math, and science.

Social development, creative arts, music, small and large motor skills are also essential for a balanced program.

TWO YEAR OLD PROGRAM

Our two year olds may attend half days or full days. Children do not need to be potty trained for this class. Our teachers are trained to work with the children in this area. We work with the children to develop their language skills as well as gain social and emotional growth. The children work with different themes each month and follow the activities pertaining to the theme of the month. The children are introduced to nursery rhymes, shapes, colors, puppetry, dramatic play, body movement, music, number concepts and other age appropriate learning skills.

THREE YEAR OLD PROGRAM

Our three year olds may also attend half days or full days. Our teachers work with these children to achieve independence and language development. We also introduce name, number and alphabet recognition. We do introduce the spatial relationships like opposite concepts, position concepts and size comparisons. The children work with the different themes each month and participate in the activities pertaining to these themes. The children are introduced to nursery rhymes, shapes, colors, body movement, music, dramatic play, block play and other age appropriate activities.

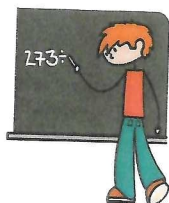
JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM
